On Tuesday, April 6, registered voters in St. Louis County have the opportunity to vote on Proposition A, a one-half cent sales tax increase to support the operation and expansion of the Metro system.

Our public transit system—made up of MetroBus, MetroLink, and Call-A-Ride operations—serves many St. Louis workers, patients, students, and sports fans.
